First Penance

- Attire: Sunday church attire
- Each child will be assigned a full pew.
- That allows about 7 guests per child (including parents). There will be no tickets.
- If there is additional room, guests will be allowed to enter on a first come, first serve basis.

First Holy Communion Location: Annunciation Church

- AES: Saturday May 7, 2022
 - 2A, 10am
 - 2B, 12pm
- Religious Education: Saturday May 14, 2022
 - A-K (last names): 10am
 - J-Z (last names): 12pm
- Each session is expected to run about 1hr, please allow for 1.5 hours.

- Practices for First Holy Communion will occur during class time for AES students.
- Practices for Religious Education students are as follows:
 - A-K: Monday May 9, 2022 & Wednesday May 11, 2022, both at 6:30pm
 - J-Z: Tuesday May 10, 2022 & Thursday May 12, 2022, both at 6:30pm
 - Practices run about one hour.

Girls: White dress, veil or hair bow or wreath of flowers, white shoes and anklets or tights. Please no makeup, nail polish, flowers, gloves or pocketbooks.

Boys: Navy blue or white jacket and navy blue or white dress slacks, shoes, socks, white shirt and white tie. Armbands are optional.

• Boutonnieres supplied.

Seating:

- Each child will be assigned a full pew.
- That allows about 7 guests per child (including parents). There will be no tickets.
- If there is additional room, guests will be allowed to enter on a first come, first serve basis.

Photography:

A photographer is booked for First Holy Communion.

Pictures inside the Church should be taken only from your pew.

Information about First Communion Banners



- First Communion banners are made of felt or other cloth connected to a dowel. They hang at the end of each family's pew during the celebration of First Communion.
- The suggested size for the banner is 10"x12", but variations of an inch or two on either side won't hurt. Please be conscious that our pews are very wide, so your ribbon needs to be at least 33" to fit over the end of the pew.
- Banners have the **child's last name** and a representation of the Eucharist, such as a chalice, grapes or wheat.
- Families with banners from their older children may use that banner instead of making a new one.
